Youth can change the future

#### **Call for Lecturer**

Montenegrin - Serbian, Bosnian, Croatian language Teacher

### GENERAL BACKGROUND

Intercultural dialogue has become one of the most pressing challenges of today's Western Balkans area and the role of youth bridging diverse communities is more necessary than ever. Providing information and knowledge about intercultural dialogue and foment mutual understanding, open mindedness and tolerance seem to be a need which is crucial for achieving tolerance.

**Center for democracy and Human Rights – CEDEM**, with partners **Institute for European Affairs** (Serbia) and **Aarhus Information Center** (Albania), has developed the project **YOUth CAN CHANGE THE FUTURE** in order to respond to the above mentioned problems and challenges and to break the prejudices and stereotypes among youth, by gathering efforts of 20 young and enthusiastic representatives of High School Student's Parlaiment and Student's Parlaiment from Montenegro, Serbia, Albania and Kosovo\*.

### **OBJECTIVES OF THE PROJECT**

**Purpose of the project** is to create a positive atmosphere where exchange and dialogue can happen and be facilitated, as well to contribute to mutual understanding and cooperation of young people by building strong and long-lasting friendships and relationships with individuals from different ethnic groups in the Western Balkan region.

**General aim** is enhancing and promotion of intercultural dialogue through raising awareness on cultural and linguistic diversity, making young people more knowledgeable, aware and mindful, thus preventing negative attitudes towards people from other societies.

**The main activity** of the project is study trip which will be implemented in Serbia, Kosovo, Albania and Montenegro – 5 days each society. The study trip includes peer-to-peer education of Montenegrin-Serbian and Albanian language, workshops on the topics related to intercultural dialogue, visits to public institutions and museums in Vranje, Prishtina, Shokdra and City of Bar. Every sub-activity will be implemented in accordance to agenda of the study trip in each region covered by the action. Working language is English.

# <u>Duties and responsibilities of the Montenegrin - Serbian, Bosnian, Croatian language</u> Teacher:

- plan, prepare and deliver(if needed) lessons (basic level A1) for the entire duration of the study visit (working time 2 hours per day)
- prepare and set initial and final tests, examination papers and exercises
- mark and provide appropriate feedback on oral and written work
- attend, supervise and contribute to peer-to-peer education during study visit

Serbia, Kosovo, Albania and Montenegro

## **Duration and time schedule**

The engagement is planned to last three weeks, during the entire period of activity implementation **between 3 September 2018 and 20 September 2018.** 

# **Qualifications and skills needed:**

- University degree;
- Good knowledge of English language;
- At least 1 years of experience in plan, prepare and deliver lessons of Montenegrin Serbian, Bosnian, Croatian language;
- Ability to attend the entire study visit;
- Ability to work in international teams

## **CONTRACT AND FEES**

Selected teacher will be invited to sign a Service Contract with CEDEM/IAE. Financial offer per each trainer cannot exceed **500 euros** in gross amount for the study trip. The payment will be made in one installment after the completion of tasks contained by assignment. Trainer is responsible for paying all the taxes related to this assignment. All costs related to the study trip (travel, accommodation, food, materials) will be provided by organizers.

### **NUMBER OF TEACHERS**

For this assignment CEDEM/IAE will contract 1 teacher.
